INTRODUCTION

DevA flying expertise currently includes but is not limited to the S61, S92, EC155 and AW139 helicopters.

EXPERIENCE OF SERVICE DELIVERY

Flexibility

- o DevA provided 2 suitably experienced and qualified crewmen and SAR equipment to CHC SAR operations in the Falkland Islands within 14 days of being requested. The crews declared operational readiness within 6 hours of arriving in the Falkland Islands.
- o DevA crews recently responded (out of hours) to an immediate Oil Rig evacuation in the Falkland Islands following an evacuation to lifeboats order due to a possible rig capsize. Reliability

o In 8 years of operating DevA contract aircrew have covered 5000 shifts with a 100% record of crews attending for duties, a 100% pass in simulator checks, a 100% pass in medical standards checks; and no shifts lost to sickness.
